ANNOUNCEMENT FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS BY Prof. Tran:

1. Undergraduate Course Requirement
Undergraduate course requirement can be waived only by taking and passing an equivalency exam. Requirement cannot be waived by taking and passing a graduate course with the required undergraduate course as a pre-requisite.
2. Core Requirement
Since not every core course is offered every semester, students should give top priorities to core courses in course selections when they are offered. There will be no replacement and/or waiver of core requirement.
3. Transfer Credit
Students who wish to transfer credit must file (within the first semester of matriculation) the Academic Petition form available from the Graduate School Office. (Graduate School policy)

4. Non-ECE Courses
Courses taken outside the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering, UML, must be pre-approved.

5. Spring 2006 Graduation
The deadline for filing the Graduate Degree Clearance Form for Spring 2006 graduation is April 20, 2006.
