Plan ahead for your transportation and parking. Downtown is walkable from either campus, and there are also buses that will get you there. If you take the bus to the Inn & Conference Center (ICC), the LAB is not far away. The PURPLE LINE of UML's (free) transportation services has a downtown stop that is almost directly across the street from the LAB.

Purple Line: Ayotte Garage- University Suites - North - Wannalancit Mills


Downtown stop is on Merrimack St. at Palmer, please let the driver know when you board the bus that you are going to the Downtown stop, when the bus approaches you will need to flag down the bus to return to campus.
