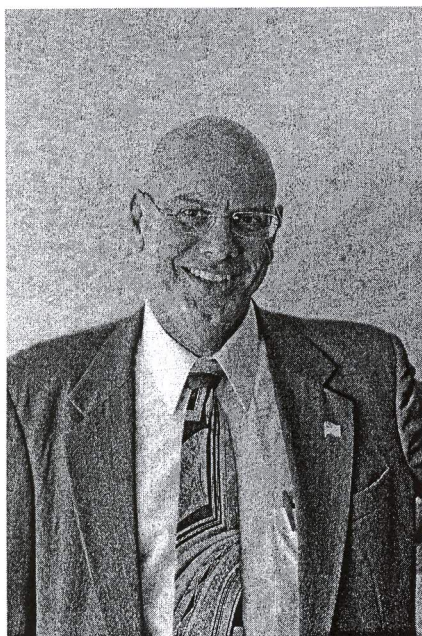


Brian Hagopian, International Society for Pharmaceutical Engineering
