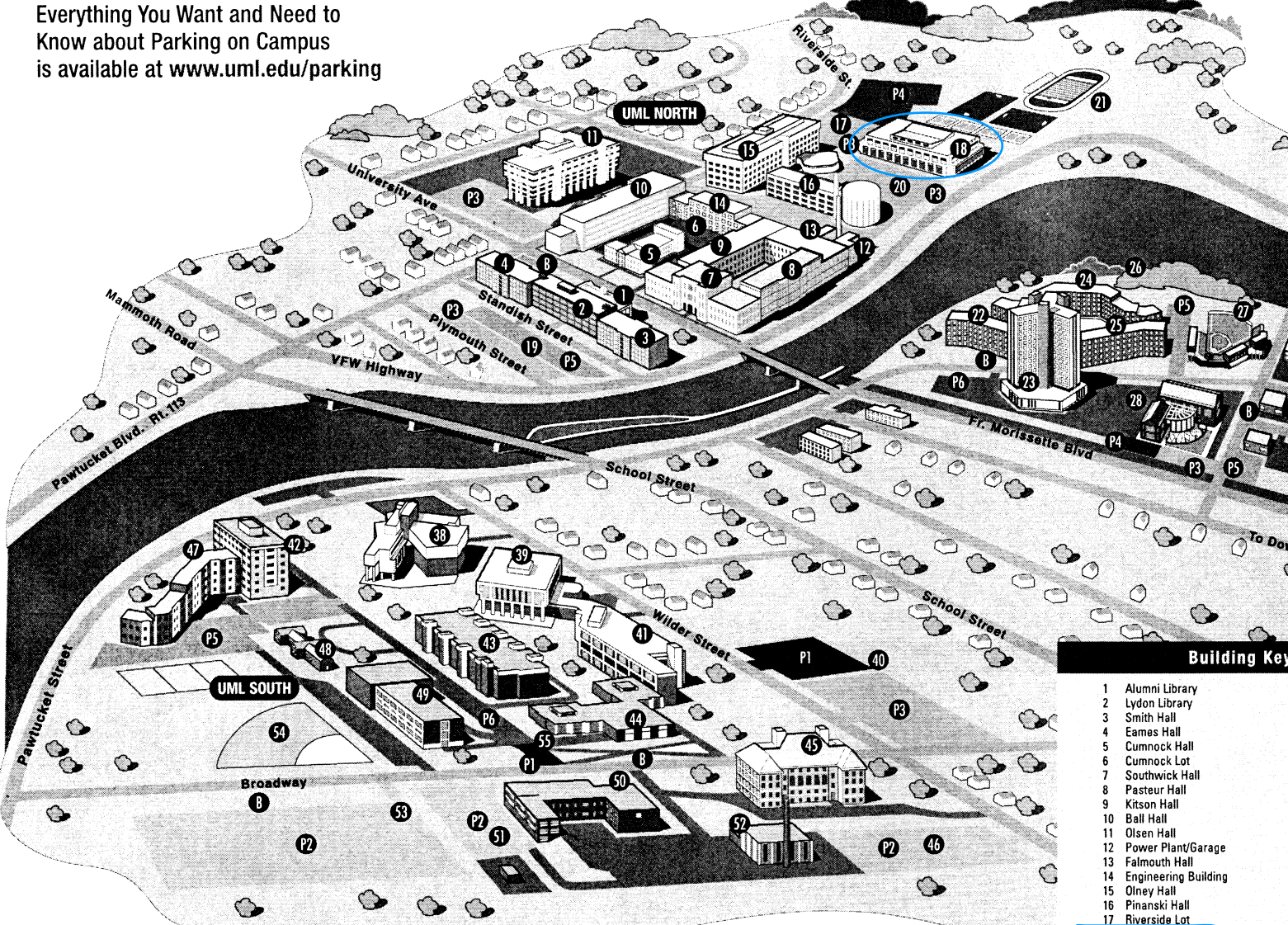

Parking on Campus

Parking Policy
Regulations regarding driving and parking vehicles on campus can be found at www.uml.edu/parking

Visitor Parking Permits
One-day visitors may park in the commuter student parking areas and designated visitor parking areas. Visitor parking permits may be obtained from University Police.

Registering Vehicles
All members of the UMass Lowell community (full-time and part-time faculty, staff and students) must register any vehicle they operate on campus. The process for registering a car on campus is explained at <http://parking.uml.edu>.

University I.D.
To register a car and to access parking lots, you must have a University I.D. New faculty and staff usually obtain an identification card as part of their intake process at Human Resources. For students, there is an I.D. Station in the basement of Southwick Hall, UML North. The I.D. schedule is available at <http://www.uml.edu/student-services/dean/ID.html>.
