

Term Paper Grading--Here's what I look for in grading Step 4:

Describing the Area of Psychopathology

Using those sources and our required readings, provide an overview of what this particular area of psychopathology “looks like”: describe typical characteristics, including DSM-5 diagnostic criteria as well as other characteristics that have been mentioned. Use your own words, and do not simply copy DSM. Include both what a “typical” case might look like as well as a summary of any important specifiers or sub-types that have been identified. Also discuss how severe it is and what impact it has on a person’s daily living, as well as whether it tends to be co-morbid with other forms of psychopathology. And be sure to talk about other forms of psychopathology that it might overlap with in ways that can make differential diagnosis tricky.
